Shoreline Update & Other Projects

Your DB board has been busy. Finalizing the living shoreline at six street. We are happy. The plants are taking route, and we hope to keep them protected so they mature to healthy plants which may take up to a year or more. Please help us by just looking and not going near the living shoreline. The fence is a reminder for us; it will stay up until they are fully matured.

Other projects include replacing some road drainage pipes. After that we will have new paving throughout the community.

The bulkhead at 6th and Creek will take another 5 months or so while we wait for permitting. The targeted date of construction is this November. Please be careful with your children in the flagged off areas.

Bamboo remediation at 2nd St on our community property is underway and should be completed in the next few months. A permit for two new piers is being submitted.
