

Design to submit for permits and approval

Deale Beach Community Resilience Project Living Shoreline for 6th Street and Bay



- Current wall and grassy area to remain in place
- Slope 6.5:1 from top of wall to beach fill of cobble/sand mix
- Planting of beachgrass/saltmarsh hay will not impair current visibility
- Path to allow access to the sandy beach
- Rock structures *reduce the force of wave action*
- Shrub plantings screen neighboring properties & enhance critical area buffer
- Permit phase to begin after community approval
- Construction phase *anticipated to begin summer 2020*
